Message From Mrs Brittain

Dear Parents and Carers,
I would like to welcome you to the autumn term at Carlisle. I am looking forward to getting to know you and your children over the coming weeks.

As many of you are aware, the front of school building project has been completed over the summer and we are now fortunate to have a safe and secure foyer area to welcome parents and visitors to the school. To further improve site safety, keypads have been installed on the three external doors.

Following the success of our volunteers' scheme last year, some of our previous volunteers have now moved into paid work and we are looking to recruit new volunteers to work in school for two or three mornings each week. Please call into the school office if you are interested. In return we will offer in class training to be a teaching assistant, specific training sessions on key curriculum areas and support with job applications.

Parents are always welcome to support children's learning. If you are not able to commit to coming into school on a regular basis, there are opportunities to help during the year on an ad-hoc basis with cooking, hearing children read and accompanying children on trips. Your class teacher will communicate

these opportunities via CSA class representatives.

It has been lovely to see so many children excited about their learning as we start the autumn term.

A more detailed newsletter will be published on 20th September and fortnightly thereafter.

School Absence-Important Procedures

Please note that any requests for absence (holiday) must now be submitted on a **'Request to authorise absence from school form'**, a copy of which can be found on the school website. Please complete when necessary and hand in to the school office.

Please also see attached term dates for next year.

Please could all parent/carers ensure they let the office know each day if their child is unwell and the nature of the illness. Medical evidence may be required for absences longer than 5 days and when attendance falls below 90%. Please note that on their return to school you must confirm in writing the reason for their absence. This letter is kept on file for the Education Welfare Officer who monitors all school attendance.

Please also provide written proof of any appointments and advise whether your child will be requiring a school meal.

May we also remind you that if your child has vomiting or diarrhoea then you must wait 48 hours from the last episode before bringing your child back to school.
