Dear Parent/Carer,

We have recently subscribed to Mathletics which is a computer programme that children can use at home to support their maths learning. Mathletics is a targeted, rewarding and captivating online resource, which is aligned to curriculum standards. Mathletics is available for your child to access from home – they simply sign in with their school username and password using any compatible computer or mobile device.

Your child's username, password and the Mathletics web address will be stuck in their reading diary. Please make a note of these details at home so you will always be able to access them. You will find additional information on a PowerPoint presentation on our website under Pupils, Mathletics, including a helpline should you need it.

We have assigned several activities for the children over the Christmas holidays based on the maths learning for the Autumn term. Only when all of the activities are completed will the children be able to access the other aspects of Mathletics. Don't feel you have to complete all the activities as we have provided you with plenty to be working on over the holidays and during the beginning of next term. From the middle of January we will then assign activities for your child based on the learning from that week. This will allow greater access to the whole site once they have completed their weekly activities. The teachers will be able to track the progress in school and assign appropriate activities based on the results from the previous activities.

Please encourage your child to use resources such as cubes, number lines and any other physical resources to solve the problems and please support them if they are finding a concept challenging. The extra Mathletics practice at home can make all the difference to your child's progress.

We hope this will facilitate some effective home learning and keep you abreast of what your child is learning in the classroom.
