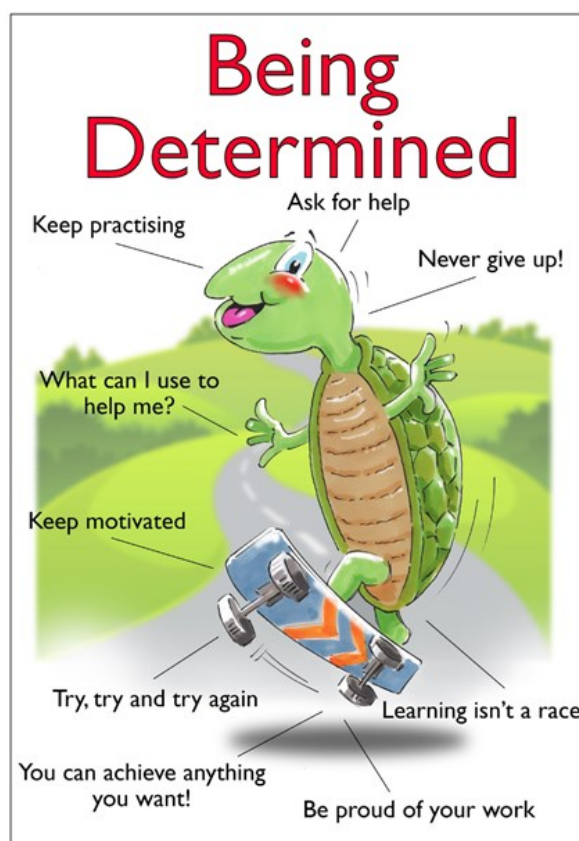

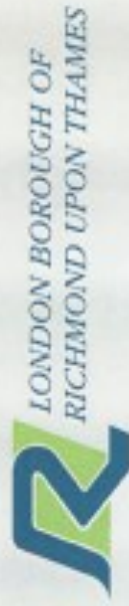

This scheme is open to anyone on a low income including pensioners and it doesn't matter if you receive help with your fuel costs from anywhere else.



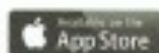
