Dear Parents/carers,

### **Illness-Important**

Please note if your child is unwell you must call the school office and let us know. You can leave an answerphone message at any time. Please ensure you give us your child's name/class and reason for absence. **If your child has any temperature/cough/sore throat or any other symptoms of Covid 19, we advise you to visit the website [111.nhs.uk](https://www.nhs.uk) (if your child is over 5 years of age), to confirm whether your child needs to be tested. If your child is under 5 years of age please call 111.**

Please note if your child has vomiting or diarrhoea they **must not** come to school for 48hours from the last episode of either diarrhoea or vomiting.

Please can we ask that if it is necessary for you to give your child calpol in the morning that you do not send them to school as usually by 11am the calpol has worn off and your child often needs to be sent home because they are feeling unwell.

### **Second Hand Uniform Sale**

There will be a second hand uniform sale tomorrow afternoon. This will be from 3pm-3.30pm in the main playground. Please can we ask all parents to respect social distancing. There will be 3 tables and clothes on each table will be sorted by age.

## Pencil Cases!

As part of our preparations for all of our pupils, we would like all children to have their own pencil case containing necessary equipment.

This will help to ensure children are not sharing regularly used stationery and children can access these materials easily from their own space. 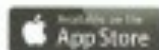
