

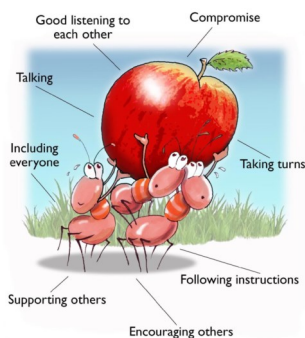

Please ensure they have a light coat in case of rain and ensure they bring a named water bottle to school every day.

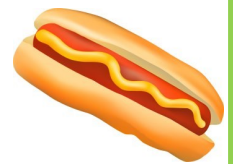
**We have noticed that a number of water bottles are in need of a thorough clean and we would encourage all parents to regularly sterilise their child's water bottle.**

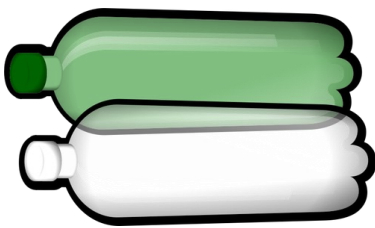


### **'Carlisle's Got Talent' -Saturday 10th July**

## Reminders

### DROP OFF AND COLLECTION TIMES

To support social distancing measures and to reduce the number of people on our site at any one time, we have staggered times of when you will need to drop off and collect your child from school.

These will be as follows:

- **Reception children need to arrive at school at 8:50am and pickup at 3.05pm**
- **Year 1 children need to arrive at school at 8:55am and pick up at 3:10pm**
- **Year 2 children need to arrive at school at 9:00am and pick up at 3:15pm**

Please can all parents adhere to the drop off and collection ONE WAY SYSTEM via the entrance gate on **Broad Lane** and the exit at the rear of the playground along the alleyway, leading to the **Uxbridge Road**.

Please only arrive at your allotted time and exit the school premises promptly. We appreciate your cooperation with this.

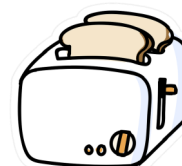
### Urgent Plea!

Please please can all parents ensure that **all items of clothing, including shoes are labelled. Any items found around school will be put in the lost property box at the front of the school. This box will be emptied at the end of each term and contents put in Bertie Bin.**



### Breakfast Club/The Hub

Please note breakfast club at both schools and the after school club The Hub (at HHJS) are open for bookings. Please remember your child must be registered before any session bookings can be made. **If your Carlisle child is attending The Hub at HHJS, please ensure you pay for the sessions via your Scopay account issued by HHJS.** If you would like to sign your child up for breakfast club, you must first complete a registration form (available from the website or school office). There are places available on all days. All places are booked using your Scopay log in.



### Illness-Important

Please note if your child is unwell you must call the school office and let us know. You can leave an answerphone message at any time. Please ensure you give us your child's name/class and reason for absence. **If your child has any temperature above 37.8/continuous new cough/ or loss of taste and smell we advise you to visit the website [111.nhs.uk](https://www.nhs.uk) (if your child is over 5 years of age), to confirm whether your child needs to be tested. If your child is under 5 years of age please call 111.**

**Please note if your child has vomiting or diarrhoea they must not come to school for 48hours from the last episode of either diarrhoea or vomiting.**

Please can we ask that if it is necessary for you to give your child Calpol in the morning that you do not send them to school as usually by 11am the Calpol has worn off and your child often needs to be sent home because they are feeling unwell.

### **Cool Milk—Reception Children-IMPORTANT INFO**

Please remember that all children under the age of 5 will receive free Government funded milk. **When your child turns 5, or if they are already over the age of 5, you have the option to pay for their milk directly through Cool Milk.**



If you would like your child to receive milk, then please visit [www.coolmilk.com](http://www.coolmilk.com) and select “register your child for milk here” then follow the on-screen instructions to register and pay. Please be aware the cut off date is Tuesday for milk orders to commence the following week. All parent/carers must contact cool milk if they have any problems.
