


Carlisle and Hampton Hill Federation News from Carlisle 6th January 2022

School Absence-Important Procedures

Please note that any requests for term time absence must be submitted on a 'Request to authorise absence from school form', a copy of which can be found on the school website or from the school office. Please complete when necessary and pop in the post box outside the school office.

Term dates are available on the school website.

Please could all parent/carers ensure they let the office know each day if their child is unwell and the nature of the illness. Medical evidence may be required for absences longer than 5 days and when attendance falls below 90%. Please note that on their return to school you must confirm in writing the reason for their absence. This letter is kept on file for the Education Welfare Officer who monitors all school attendance.

Please also provide written proof of any appointments and advise whether your child will be requiring a school meal.

May we also remind you that if your child has vomiting or diarrhoea, you must wait 48 hours from the last episode before bringing your child back to school.

<u>Covid-19</u>

Please note if your child or any member of your household displays <u>any one</u> of the Covid Symptoms you must call 119 and book a <u>PCR test (this is a test that is sent to</u> a lab). Even if your child's symptoms are mild.

- 1.A temp of 37.8+
- 2.A new continuous cough for 1 hour, or 3 coughing episodes in 24 hours
- 3.Loss of taste/smell

Cool Milk—Reception Children-IMPORTANT INFO

Please remember that all children under the age of 5 will receive free Government funded milk. When your child turns 5, or if they are already over the age of 5, you have the option to pay for their milk directly through Cool Milk.

If you would like your child to receive milk, then please visit www.coolmilk.com and select "register your child for milk here" then follow the on-screen instructions to register and pay.

Please be aware the cut off date is Tuesday for milk orders to commence the following week. All parent/carers must contact cool milk if they have any problems.
