Message From Ms Brittain—Headteacher


Dear Parents/carers,

Important Notices/ Reminders

School Attendance—Reminder-School Day Start/Finish Times

Reception arrive between 8.45-9am and finish at 3.05pm

Y1 & Y2 to be ready and awaiting class teacher by 8.55am in the playground. Finish time is 3.15pm.

Please remember afterschool clubs finish at 4.15pm, with the exception of Baking Club which finishes at 4.30pm. Please arrive on time to collect your child and make sure that if your child has brought a bike or scooter to school that it is left at the front of the school.

Please note it is very disruptive for <u>all members of staff</u> when your child arrives late to school, especially the class teacher who has already explained the lesson to the children. Please assist us by ensuring your child is here on time.

School Absence-Important Procedures

We would also like to remind all parents that you <u>must call the school office each day</u> to report your child's absence and the nature of the illness. If we do not hear from you, it will be noted on our attendance register as unauthorised absence. Please note this forms part of our safeguarding procedure.

Medical evidence may be required for absences longer than 5 days and when attendance falls below 90%. If your child has a planned absence, please let the office know and we will inform the class teacher.

Please also provide written proof of any appointments and advise Whether your child will be requiring a school meal, if attending after the appointment.

May we also remind you that if your child has vomiting and/or diarrhoea, you must wait 48 hours from the last episode before bringing your child back to school.
