

## Introducing the Parent Portal (School Screener)

School Health Services will be using a new electronic way of communicating with parents and carers through a secure web-based portal. Parents and carers of children in **Reception and Year 6** are being asked to register on the portal to receive information and register on the 2023-2024 NCMP (National Child Measurement Programme) and to opt out should you wish to, using the following link: <a href="https://app.schoolscreener.com/Portal/#/36378/p/WR259/102883">https://app.schoolscreener.com/Portal/#/36378/p/WR259/102883</a>

It's a really quick process and all you need is an email address which you have access to. Once registered you can login and add your child/ren's details. We request that 4-6 weeks after the measurement has taken place you log into your School Screener account to view your child's result letter. The parent portal is GDPR compliant, so both parent and child's personal data is safer too.
